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About the Wusun Ancient Trail

The Wusun Ancient Trail was a major transport artery in the Western Han period, connecting Wusun Kingdom in the north to the state of Guishuang in the south. It served as a strategic corridor through the Tianshan Mountains linking north and south. From the Han and Tang dynasties to the Qing dynasty and Republican era, there have been historical records of people traveling this route. Even during the chaotic rebellions of the Qing, the government designated this area as a passageway. Remnants of past civilizations such as fortress ruins, beacon towers, and ancient military posts can still be found along the trail. For example, near the mouth of the river valley at the exit of the Bohu-Kuga trail, there remains a mural with inscriptions from the Eastern Han period (around 158 AD) commemorating General Ban Chao's conquest. Along with the site of the "Governor's Pavilion" and carved Han characters, these form valuable historical and archaeological relics.

Together with the ancient trails of Yecheng and the Tiemenguan-Wolf Tower Route, the Wusun Trail is recognized as one of the "Three Classic Expedition Routes" for outdoor exploration in Xinjiang. Among the three, the Wusun Trail is considered the most breathtaking in terms of landscape.



The Wusun Trail is often hailed as the most beautiful ancient trail in China—its reputation well deserved. Among all, the segment praised as the most enchanting is the stretch often referred to as the "Heavenly Lake," a glacial lake with an elevation of 3,000 meters and a surface area of over 40 square kilometers. It lies beneath the towering peaks of the Tianshan Mountains in Aksu Prefecture, near the village of Awat.

The trail also runs alongside the upper reaches of the Kekesu River, with dramatic gorges cutting through the land for hundreds of kilometers, showcasing iconic landscapes of the western slopes of the Tianshan Mountains.

Day 1

Depart > Urumqi ~ Yining

Upon arrival in Yining, feel free to explore and check in at Kazanqi Folk Culture Street and Liuxing Street.



Yining ~ Khunjerab Village (2000m) ~ Camp D1 (2800m)

Khunjerab is a scenic Yili village surrounded by snowy peaks and grasslands, known for nomadic culture and as the Wusun Trail starting point.

Depart at 8:00 AM by private car. Hike ~15km and camp based on conditions.

Day 3 Hiking: 20km / approx. 9 hrs Camp D1 ~ Khunjerab Pass (3730m) ~ Camp D2 (3300m)

Today's trek is about 20km, taking around 9 hours. The route passes through grasslands, wilderness, and snowy scenery, ascending rocky trails layer by layer. At the Qiong Daban Pass, panoramic views unfold. Descend to the campsite takes about 1 more hour.



Camp D2 ~ Koksu River ~ Tianshan Gorge ~ Camp D3 (2720m)

Trek along rivers and forests, through deep valleys and lush woods. Cross the turquoise Koksu River to reach Camp D3.











Day 5 Hiking: 15km / approx. 8 hrs

Camp D3 ~ Grassland Station ~ Paradise Lake Camp (3050m)

Arrive at Paradise Lake by 5PM after a 15km hike. This is the most scenic campsite along the route - perfect for rest and photo ops. Prepare for the toughest pass the next day.



Camp D4 ~ Akbulak Pass (3860m) ~ **Bogda River Valley Camp (2800m)**

Akbulak Pass is the highest and most challenging part of the trail, often snowy even in summer. After crossing, descend to the river valley and camp.

Day 7 Hiking: 28km / approx. 9 hrs

Camp D5 ~ Bogda Valley Exit (2180m) ~ Heiying Village (1930m) ~ Kuqa

Long river-crossing day (30-50 times). Start at 9AM, reach the exit by 5-6PM. Change into water shoes often. Take private car to Kuqa for overnight stay.

Day 8

Kuqa ~ Urumqi 노 Return Home

End of Wusun Trail trek. Guide will arrange airport transfer based on your flight.



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
